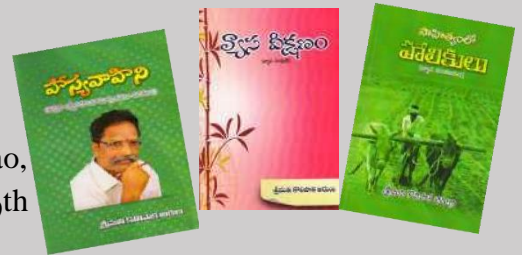
7. Mrs. Kolipaka Aruna, Department of Telugu, Published three Books With ISBN In Telugu zLiterature. They are,
