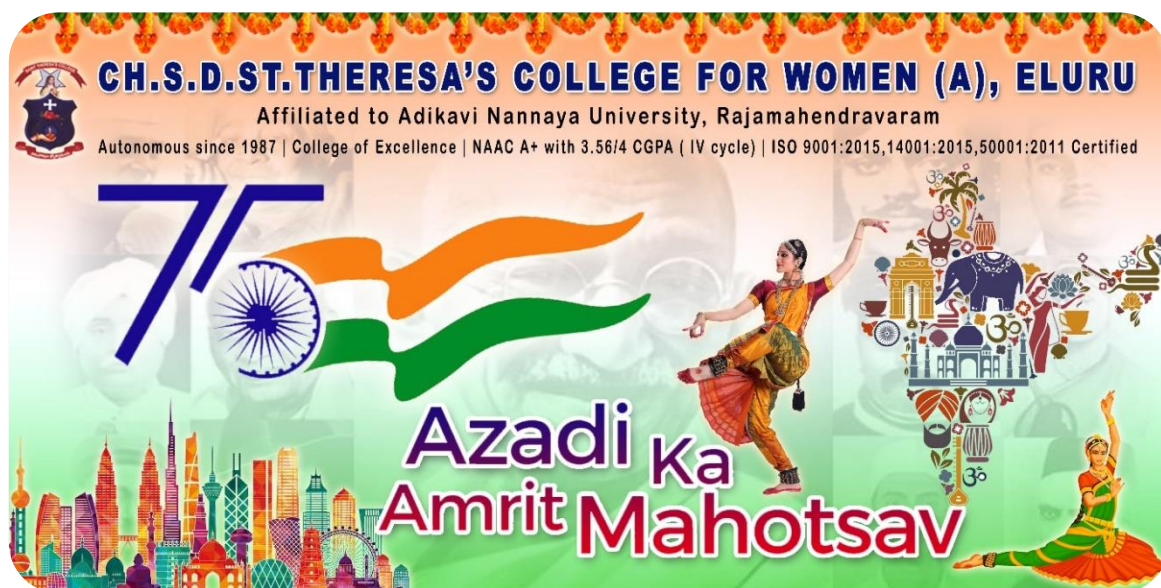

AWARENESS PROGRAM

On August 3, 2022, CH.S.D.ST.Theresa's College for Women (A), Eluru organised a guest lecture on "Women's role in the freedom fight" as a part of "AzadikaAmritMahostav." The department of social sciences and the centre for women's studies at CH.S.D.ST. Theresa's College for Women in Eluru, led by the college's Principal, Dr. Sr. P. Mercy, organised the event.

Members of the All India Democratic Women's Association served as the program's resource persons. The students were given a thorough explanation by the chief guest, Mrs. D. Rama Devi of the AIDWA State Secretary, of the sacrifices made by our great heroes during the freedom movement to declare India independent. She also emphasised the importance of women in the Indian liberation movement.

The session came to an end with a message from Dr. Sr. Mercy Principals explaining why it was important to start the two-week AzadikaAmritMahotsav celebration with AIDWA because it is a rightward independent women's organisation dedicated to achieving democracy, equality, and women's emancipation. No matter their class, caste, or community, the members come from all social classes. With more than 9 million active members, it has organisational presence in 23 Indian states. About two-thirds of the organisation's strength is derived from poor a rural and urban woman, which aligns with the college's mission.

Photo Exhibition of “British to Free India”:

As part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav programme, District Youth Services, Information Department and St. Theresa's College jointly launched a photo exhibition with the biographies of the fighters who laid down their lives for the freedom of the country on Saturday. On this occasion, Revenue Divisional Officer Panchala Kishore said today's youth should join the development of the country while remembering the sacrifices of the warriors who willingly laid down their lives for the freedom of the country. He continued that many patriots joined the British to free India from the shackles of slavery. They said that they fought and sacrificed their lives for the sake of future generations and got the independence, and with the inspiration of their ambitions, today's youth should work hard to keep the country on the path of development. He said that there is an enormous wealth of human resources in India, and that human intelligence should be used for the development of the country instead of migrating to other countries.

Set well CEO Mr.M.D. Mehraj said that today's youth should remember the martyrs who sacrificed their lives in the freedom struggle to enlighten the present generation about the life stories of the freedom fighters, a photo exhibition with their photos were arranged. Sr Mercy, Principal said that as part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav program, various programs are being organized in the college till 15th of this month and every day documentary films with moments of freedom struggle were being shown. Prominent social reformer Gudipati Narasimha Rao, Lecturer Emmanuel, District Tourism Development Officer Pattabhiramaiah spoke in the programme.

Event was a grand success with 1500 student participation along with College Correspondent Sr. Marietta Pudota, Principal Sister Mercy, District Information Civil Relations Officer Kumari S. Bhavani and Prabhi.

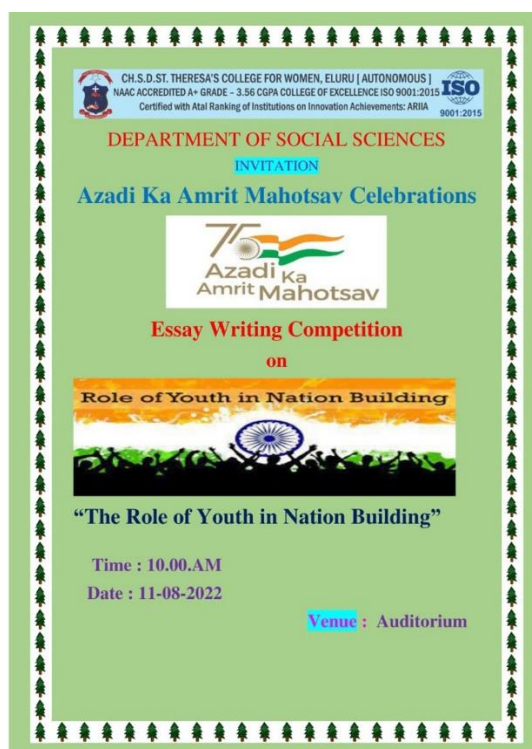
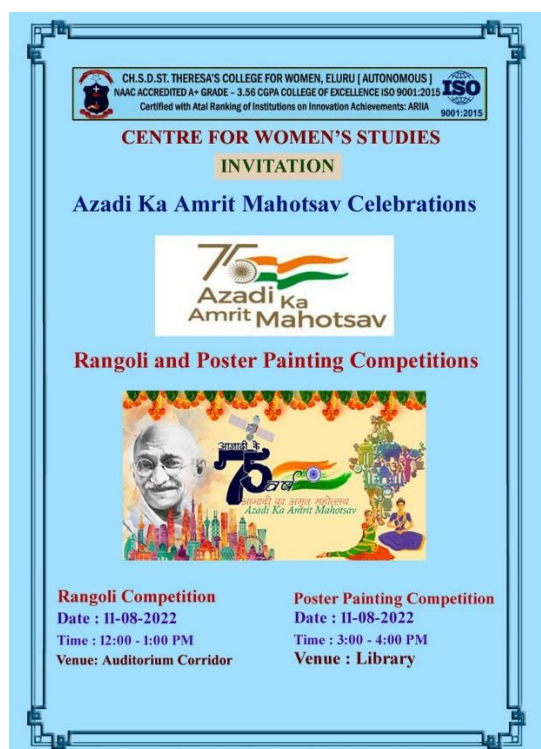
Around 2035 students and staff witnessed the role of freedom fighters in getting India free from Britishers. Every day the program came to an end with National Anthem.

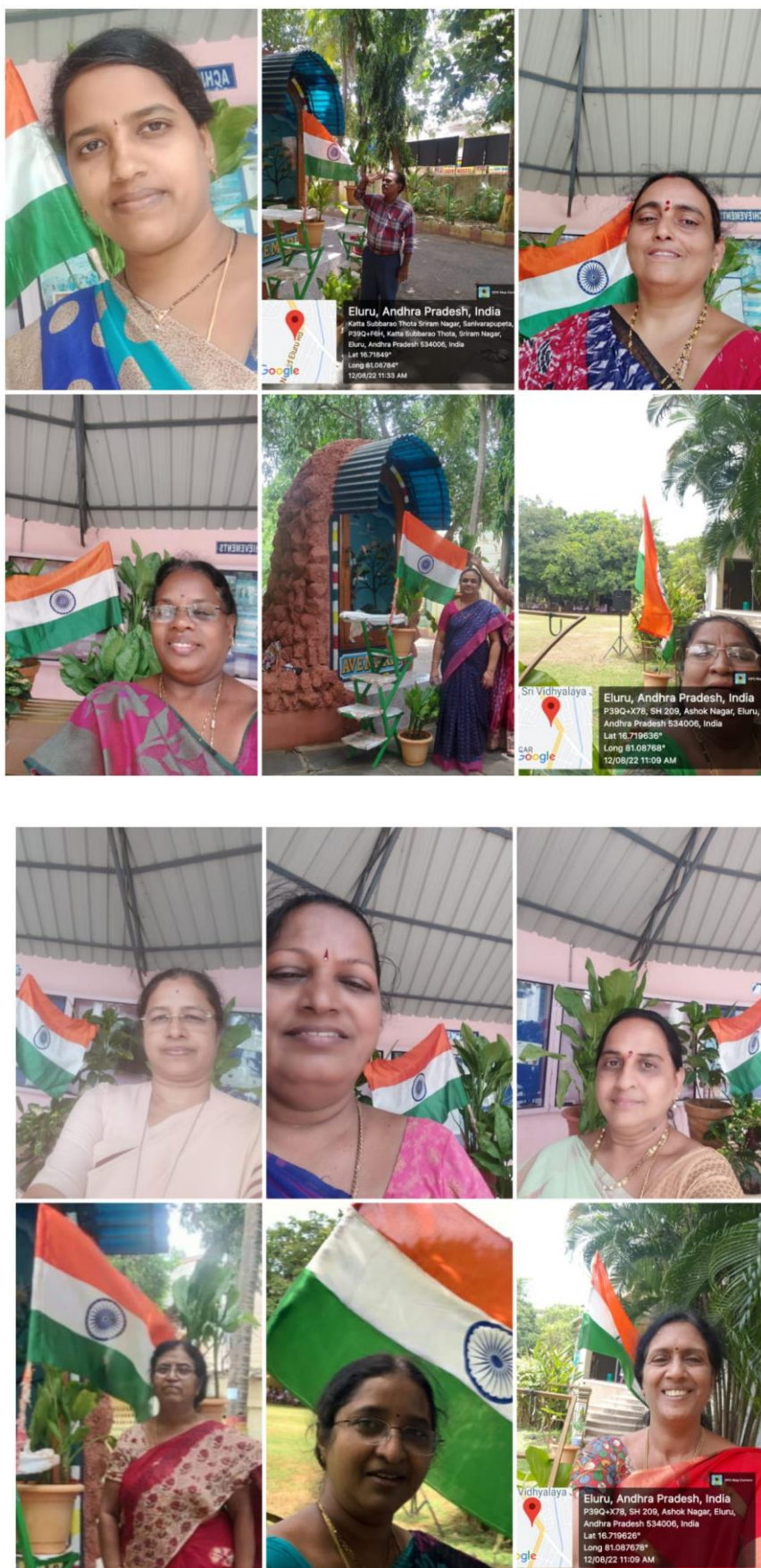

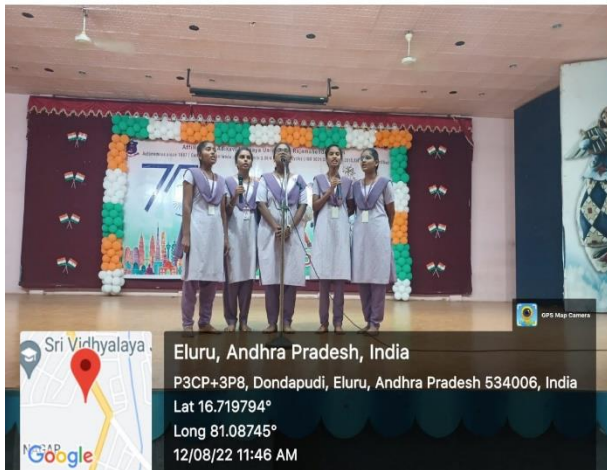
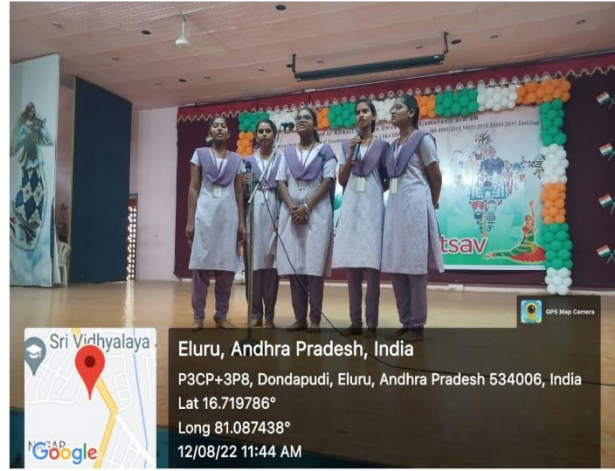
Tree plantation program was undertaken within the college campus and in the neighbourhood.
