

15 days Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course for I Year Degree students,  $6^{th}$  July -  $22^{nd}$  July, 2023

Keeping in view the growing need for command over Communicative English, the Department of English, Ch. S. D. St. Theresa's College for Women(A), Eluru has launched an Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course for the I year students who joined the college in this academic year 2022-23. The Programme is being conducted under the able guidance of the Principal of the college Dr. Sr. Mercy. P and The Vice Principal Sr. Maria Christia and under the leadership of Dr. R. Madhavi, Head of the Department of English, Dr. D. Fathima Rani, Dr. D. Rajani D, Mrs. M.K. Padma Lata, Mrs. K. Beaula Swarupa, Ms. D. Mani Bhagya Sree and Mrs. R. Sonia Priyadarshini and Mrs. S. Hima Bindu trained the students in various skills such as Public Speaking, Accent Training and Functional English. The course was conducted from 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 to 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2023.

The Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course is being conducted to optimize the Language skills of students coming from different backgrounds, and make the shed their inhibitions in using the English language. The methodologies adopted in the Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course include usage of Audio and Video Aids along with songs, remedial language training and oral and aural skill training.

Nearly 250 students from all combinations attended the Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course and improved their LSRW skills in English language. Topics like Significance of Spoken English, conversational skills like Introducing self and others, Asking and Giving Information, Giving Instructions and Directions, Role Play and Agreeing and Disagreeing, Topics from Functional English like Verb forms for different time lines, Vocabulary Building like use of prefixes and suffixes, use of Idiomatic English and Writing Skills like Letter Writing, Developing Conversations for role plays etc. were dealt with. Apart from the ICT and other audio visual aids, Peer learning and group work were used as great motivators for all the participants.

On the final day of the Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course feedback will be collected from the students and a test on the inputs is slated to be conducted in methods like oral test, written test, JAM, conversations etc. The majority of students expressed their delight on the conduct of the Intensive Communicative English Bridge Course. They are satisfied with the course for becoming aware of various methods in which they are able to strengthen their communicative skills in English.


