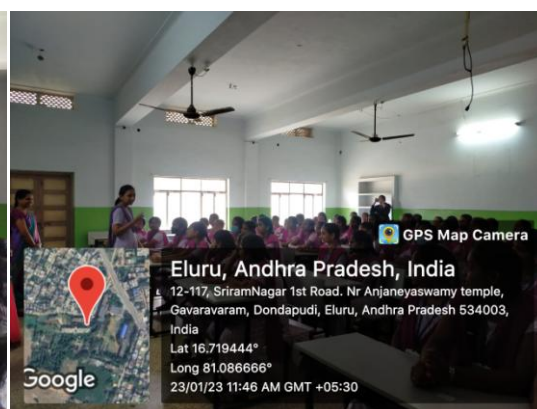
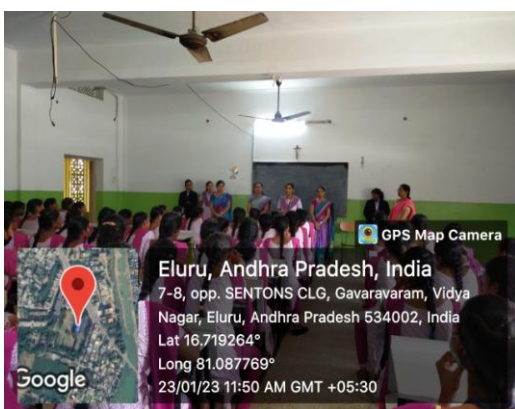
Faculty Achievement:

Faculty Achievement:

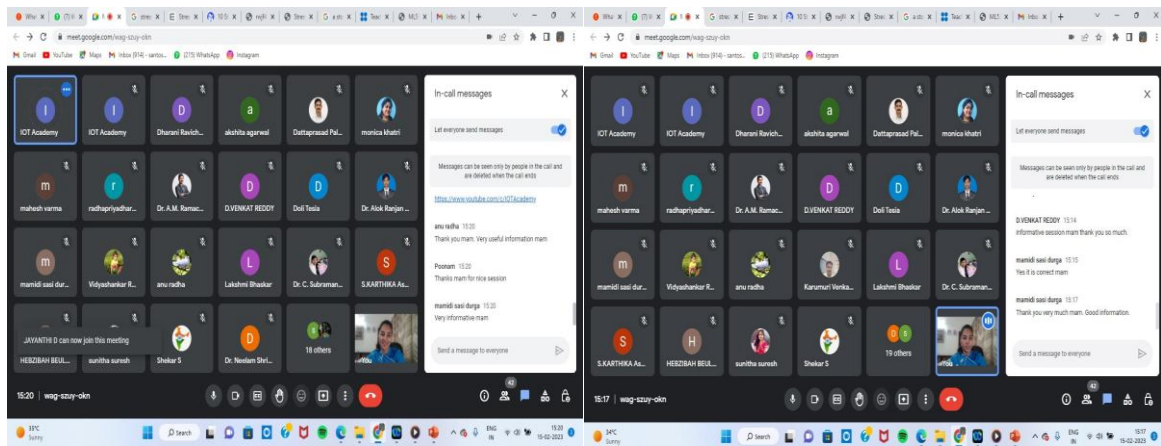

Dr. Santosh Jhavar, Head, Department of Management Studies conducted a session on “**How to Balance Career & Personal Life”- Tips for Teachers** for the Junior faculty of our college at 10 a.m. on 24th March 2023 in Media centre. The program started with a prayer by Mrs. Philomena & team. The participants were 30 in number.

The session began with a short story on Work life balance & its importance. A brief history was narrated as how the concept evolved over the years. The participants were asked as why they chose to be teachers. The participants interacted enthusiastically. The aim of the session was to discuss the ways as how to achieve work life balance and reduce the level of stress as teachers. Tips to be a happy teacher were given along with Time Management strategies so as to distinguish between work & life.

Before the session was concluded, the participants were given a Quiz on Work Life to check whether they were in balance.
