BOS meeting

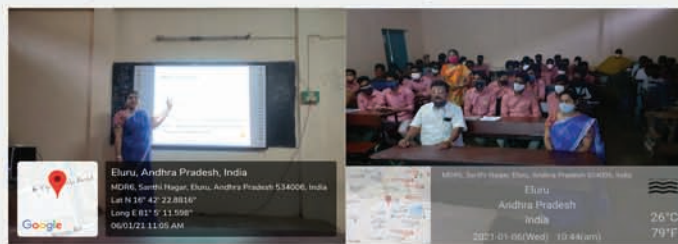

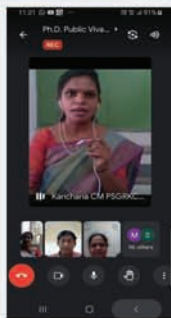
International Programmers day

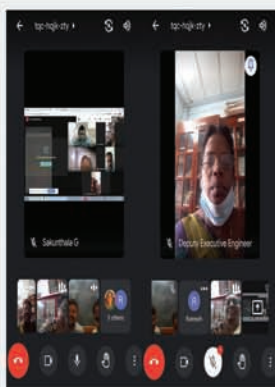


LMS Training Program Organized

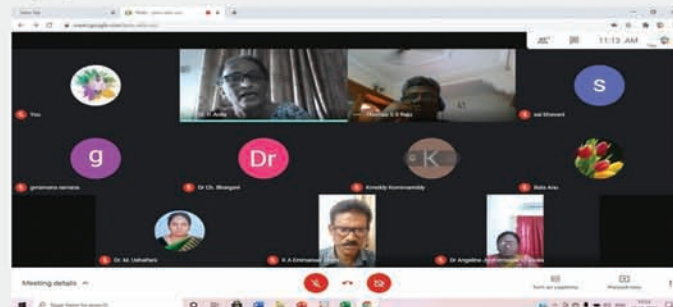
Mr. Murali Krishna, Secretary of Gosamrakshana Samithi, Eluru trained the

Azolla Harvest

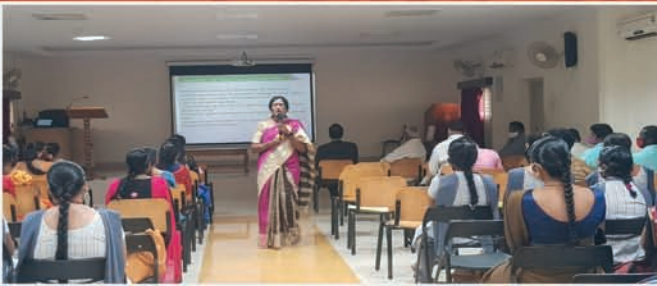

Inauguration of the Arts club

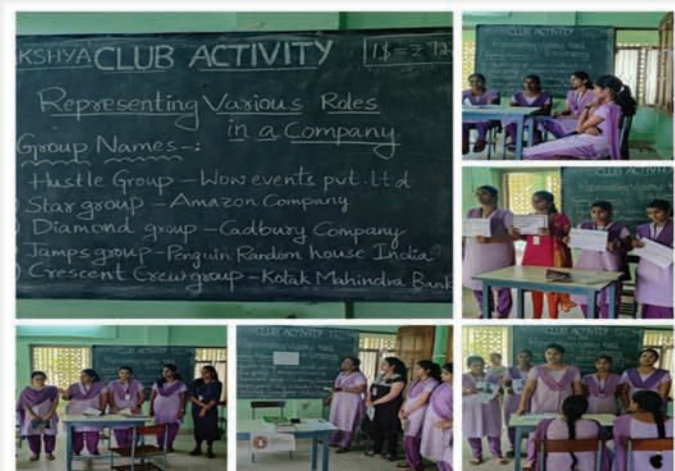

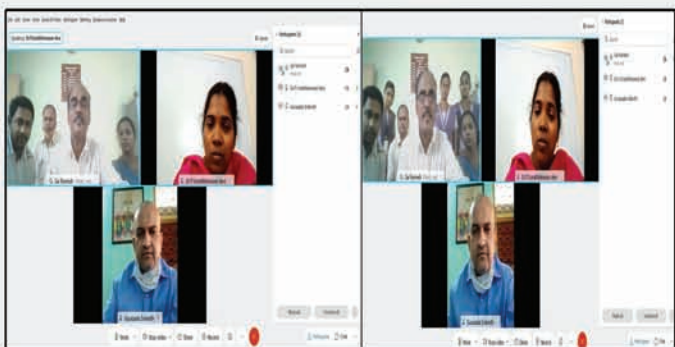

Boards of studies meeting was organized by different departments to discuss various aspects of the academic year 2021 syllabi

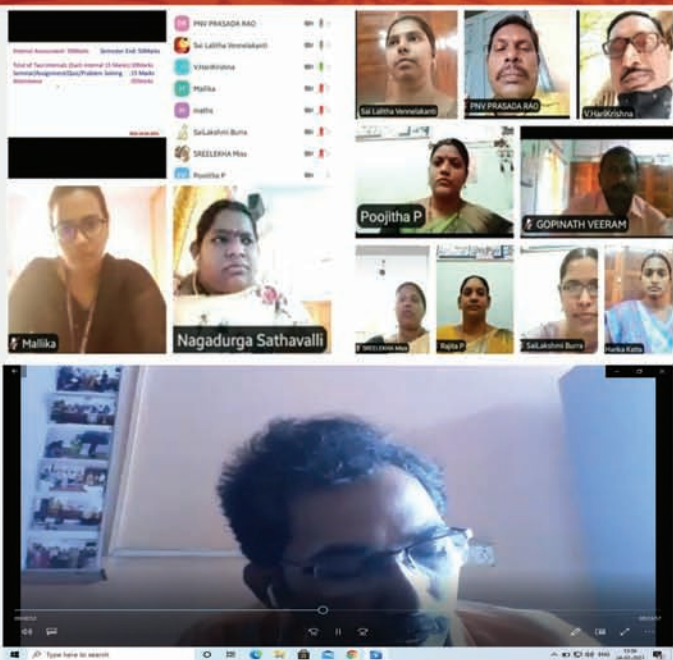

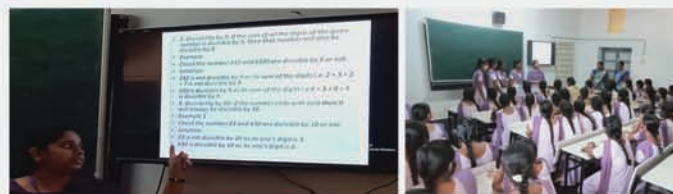
National Science Day celebrations
