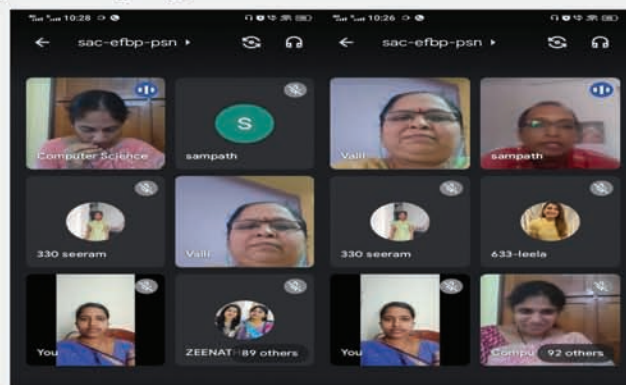

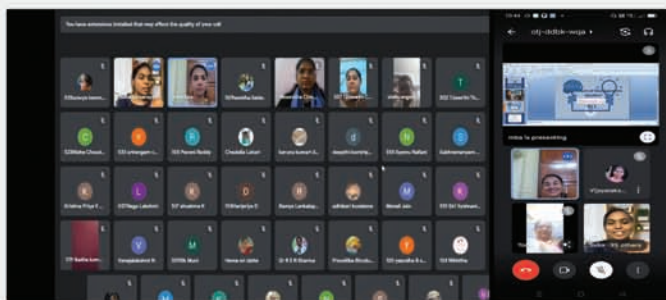
Attended Online Course

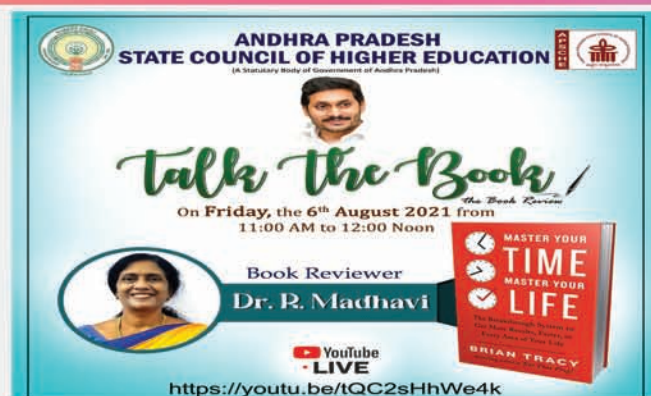

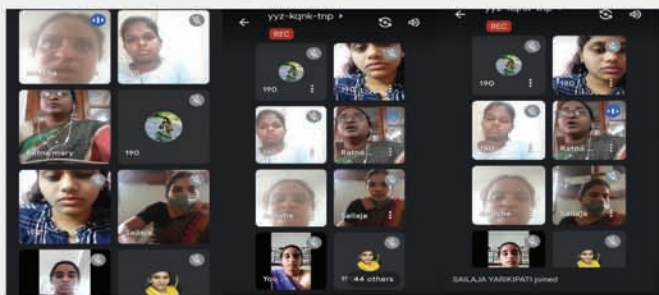


Birth Anniversary of Sri Tanguturi Prakashampanthulu.

BOS Meeting

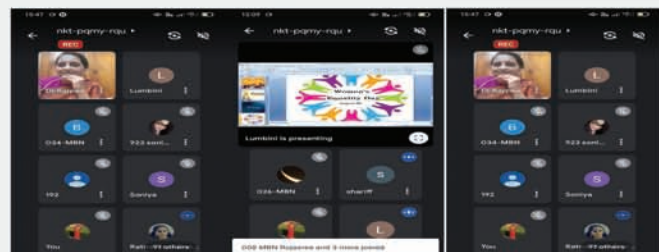

National Nutrition Week

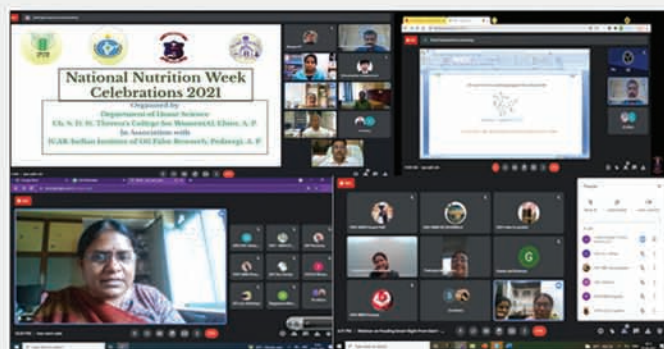

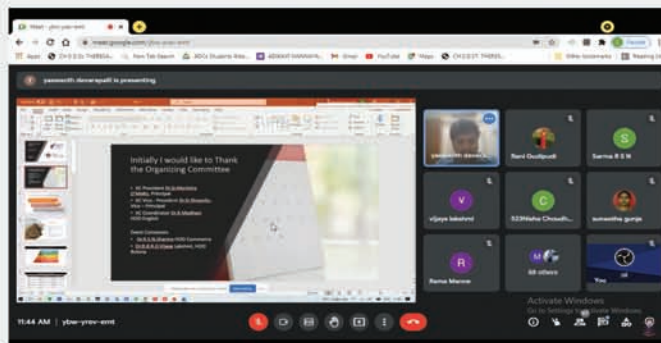

Inauguration of E-Hub

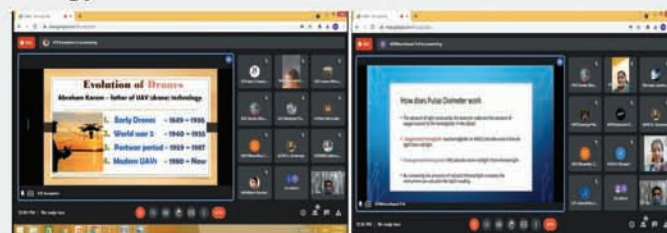

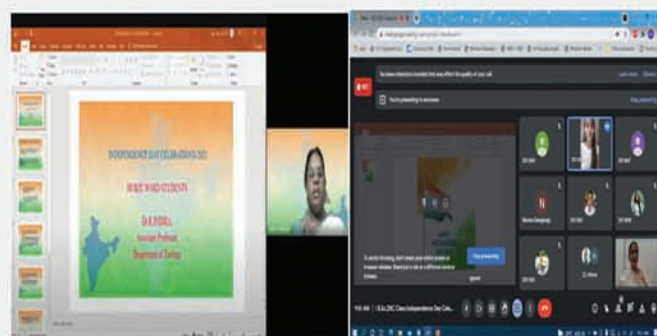
