## THE PROGRAMME AND ITS RATIONALE

The educational **student and faculty exchange programme** to Bangkok, Thailand was conducted from 13<sup>th</sup> November 2019 to 20<sup>th</sup> November 2019, under the joint collaboration of CH.SD.ST.THERESA'S AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, ELURU and IMRF Thailand Chapter. A group of faculty members and students were a part of this student exchange programme. The total number of delegates who participated in this programme were 34 including The principal, Dr Sr. Marietta D'Mello, faculty and the students. The purpose of this exchange programme was to facilitate MOU with the foreign countries, to improve the skills and qualities in the students and to interact with the students and professors of other universities, and participate in a Multi-Disciplinary International Conference and present academic papers.



## DAY.1: 14<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2019

After reaching Bangkok, the group checked in the hotel IBIS Bangkok Riverside. After lunch, the group went on an interesting boat safari on the Chaou Phyara river where various provinces, landmarks and life of

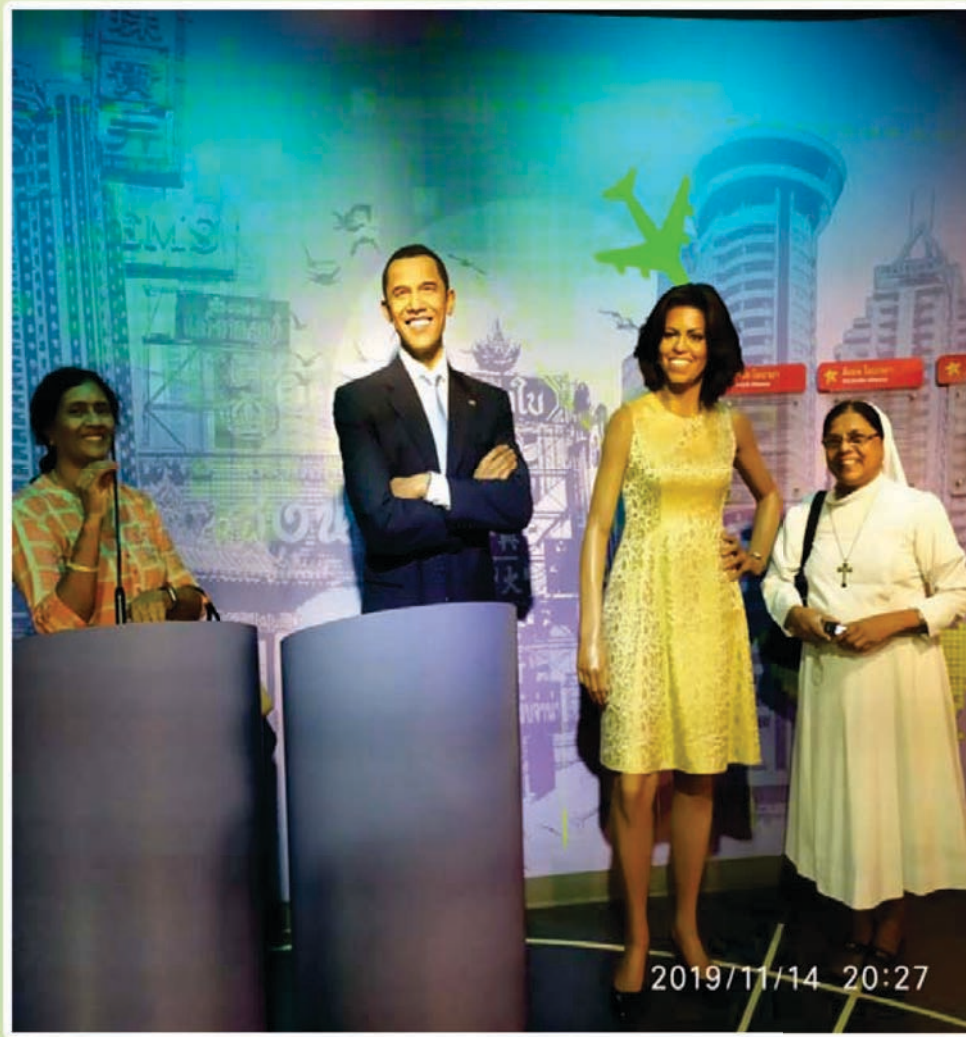
