On 18th October, 2014 all the students of units I to IX, who are involved in the project work, gathered for a road show at nine different places by nine teams such as Adivarapu Peta. The students are actively involved in the awareness programme. They tried their level best to convey the idea of **SWACHCH BHARAT**. The Mayor and the municipal commissioner were the chief guest and guest of honour for the inaugural session of Theresian Swachch Bharat Abhiyan. The staff members, students, residents of the area and municipality staff participated in the program.

Students explained very clearly about the disposal of solid waste and various controlling measures of solid waste. The members explained about the drastic effects of plastics and also gave a poem related to the harmful effects of plastics. The guests addressed the students and congratulated them for their efforts

The Eco club members of the college explained various activities under taken by them for the protection of the environment. Then all the members took a pledge regarding their responsibility to the Swachacha Bharat. Then all the students went on a rally displaying the placards related to solid waste management and finally participated in cleaning programme arming the brooms.

KSR Thota was Adopted on 20th November, 2014

For The adaptation of KSR Thota and Sree Ram Nagar Colony, a programme with the ward members, Panchayat President and other important members of the colony was organized .Considering the suggestions and advices of the residences of KSR thota, it was decided to collect the waste from door to door and dispose it in a proper way. Regularly it has been working. It was also decided to clean the empty sites which were being used as dump yards till now. 50-60 trucks of waste was cleared from KSR Thota . Above 600 plants were planted .

On 22nd November, 2015 the college provided two dust bins for each resident of KSR Thota to segregate the waste at source as dry and wet, to collect this waste two persons were hired (with salary 10,000/- per month) and necessary arrangement were made.









The plantation day was celebrated by supplying the manure to the existing plants in the adopted area of KSRThota, in which Sr.Showrilu ,the Vice Principal & Sr.MariettaD'Mello, PG Directress, and the students of Eco Club participated.







Ch.S.D.St.Theresa's Autonomous College for Women, Eluru gave Rs.14,500 to purchase a rickshaw to Sri Ram Nagar colony, in order to collect the garbage from door to door, the local leaders are satisfied with the work and they immediately sanctioned the fund for the construction of Community hall in the adopted colony KSR Thota.





With the cooperation of residents of KSR thota various activities such as arranging the rickshaw to collect the waste from the houses, distribution of two colour dustbins to collect the waste separately as degradable and non degradable, plantation & their survival , construction of roads and community hall etc.. are being took place.
